1. If student is **NOT ZONED** for Fairview Middle School: **submit school choice form** to School Choice Office (Leon County Schools, 2757 W. Pensacola Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32304 or fax to (850) 487-7291) **WITH ALL REQUIRED SIGNATURES**. This form is located on the Fairview IB Preparatory website as well as Leon County Schools' website.
2. All students making application: **submit IB Prep application** to Fairview Middle School IB Prep Office, on or before March 1st of entrance year. Applications are available on the FMS website: [www.fairview.leon.k12.fl.us/magnet.html](http://www.fairview.leon.k12.fl.us/magnet.html)
3. **Optional:** Interested students may schedule a shadowing date with the IB Prep Program by contacting Ms. Meghan Davis, IB Prep Coordinator, at 488-6880 x122. Shadowing students will be provided with a written excuse note from Fairview at the conclusion of their shadowing date.

## A Unique Program

### THE DIFFERENCE OF IB PREP



The IB Prep Magnet Program at Fairview is an accelerated academic program with a multicultural focus. Students are advanced in all curricular areas, not just a few, and have the opportunity to explore three different foreign languages. Twelve IB Prep Magnet teachers, trained in the IB philosophy and curriculum, work in teams at each grade level to provide students with a unique and challenging academic experience. A dedicated magnet coordinator works daily with IB Prep students and families to ensure their success.

Bus transportation to Fairview is provided to all IB Prep Magnet students from anywhere in the Leon County School district.

### IB PREP EXPECTATIONS

High expectations are set for IB Prep Magnet students at Fairview Middle School. Students in the IB Prep Magnet program are expected to :



- Maintain a C-average in all academic classes.
- Stay involved with their school and local community by completing creative, action and service hours each year of participation.
- Demonstrate a high level of respect for their academic peers, teachers, and themselves by following the IB Prep Honor Code.
- Encourage their parents to participate in our IB Parent Partnership group, which meets quarterly.

## Academic Offerings

### IB PREP CURRICULUM

The IB Prep Magnet program curriculum is based on international standards, giving the accelerated curriculum a multicultural focus and a holistic approach to learning. While advancing their studies, students learn about the world around them, their role in it, and ways they can change it for the better. The accelerated curriculum is preparation for any advanced program of study offered at any high school, from AP classes to the IB diploma. The IB Prep program will open up many doors, creating new and exciting opportunities for your future!

### HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT OPTIONS

Students in the IB Prep Magnet program have the opportunity to earn up to 8 high school credit hours in middle school. These include the subjects of Algebra I Honors, Geometry Honors, Biology Honors, Physical Science Honors, French I and 2 Honors, Spanish I and 2 Honors, Chinese I and 2, and Journalism!

### ELECTIVE OPTIONS



Students at Fairview can choose from a wide variety of elective options, which include the Foreign Languages listed above, as well as journalism, drama, guitar, chorus, band, orchestra, art,

Physical Education and SSTRIDE. Students in the 6th grade magnet program have a special opportunity by participating in our Foreign Language Wheel, which includes nine weeks each of introductory Spanish, French, Chinese, and technology.
